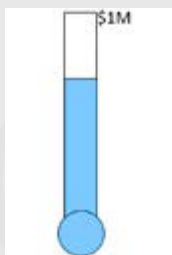
#### Improving Treatment for Breast Cancer Survivors with Post Treatment Memory Loss



In a new study that could help improve the day-to-day quality-of-life for women with breast cancer, JCCC member Dr. Patricia Ganz and colleagues have developed a rehabilitation program to address post-cancer treatment cognitive changes. Often known as "chemo brain," the condition can affect organizational skills and daily functioning in up to 35 percent of post-treatment breast cancer patients.
