

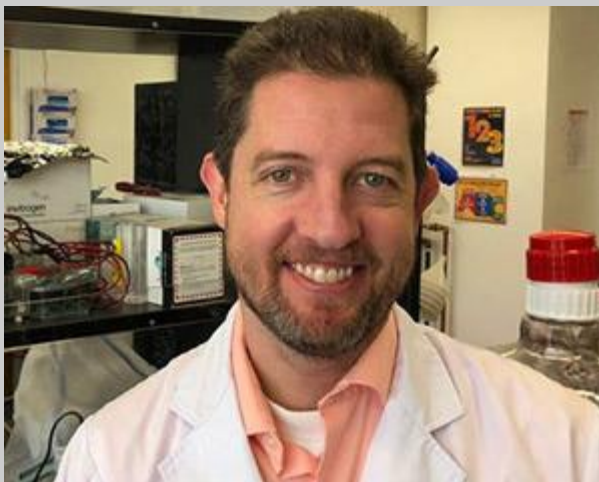

Acclaimed specialist in big data and cancer joins UCLA

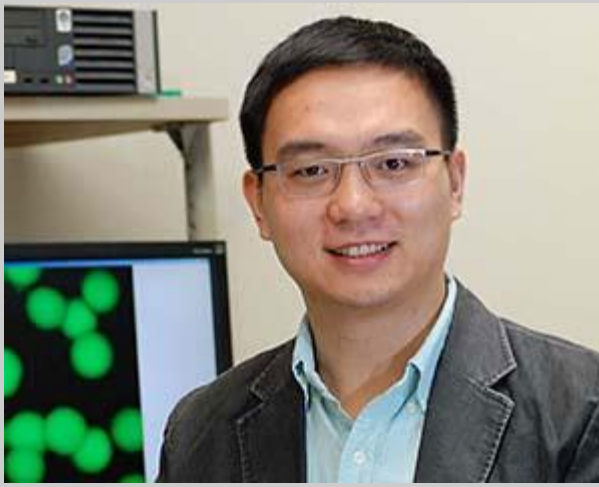

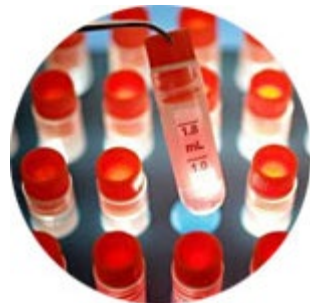

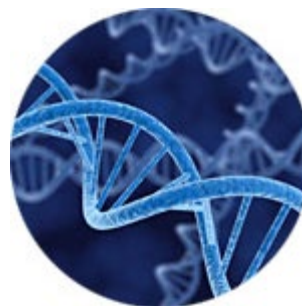
